

## Instructions per Betsy Orman of the Waukesha Kennel Club 2022

- page 1 - under the All Events require - you have to provide 2 items of the 3 - list of Club officers & current membership list. You are not holding a special event so that is N/A
- Under Specialty Shows - scroll to Page 2 and look for Designated Specialties - you complete the application as directed (pages 1,2,3,& 6) and submit to AKC with your application fee and the host club consent form (attached)
- Ignore the rest of the checklist form  
For the actual application document (also attached). Note page #s are in the doc, NOT the pdf...
- Page 1 - Club name, Event # from 2022, check box for Fully Superintended - MBF Dog shows; you can name a Club Member as Event chair OR name Jenn Stagg (as you are part of OUR show) & Officer signature
- Page 2 - answers are Territory? No, it's your territory. Ed requirements & Disaster plan - YES (that is on Waukesha) and No to Televised. Ignore the multiple option as that doesn't apply to specialty clubs
- Page 3 - Check Specialty. Then check yes for Juniors (no need to answer the Q about what breeds, that is only if you were a Group Club like Northstar Herding Club) ; Yes for NOHS and No for Benched. I believe entry fees will stay at \$32 for first and \$25 for 2nd - Jenn Stagg pls confirm
- Under Specialty Shows - check Designated and fill in Waukesha Kennel Club. & check Yes to "held in conjunction"
- Check yes or no to holding sweeps, whichever you plan to do
- Ignore the Judges Panel - you are using a judge from OUR panel so we complete the panel
- Page 6 - fees, pretty self explanatory
